LEARNING GOALS

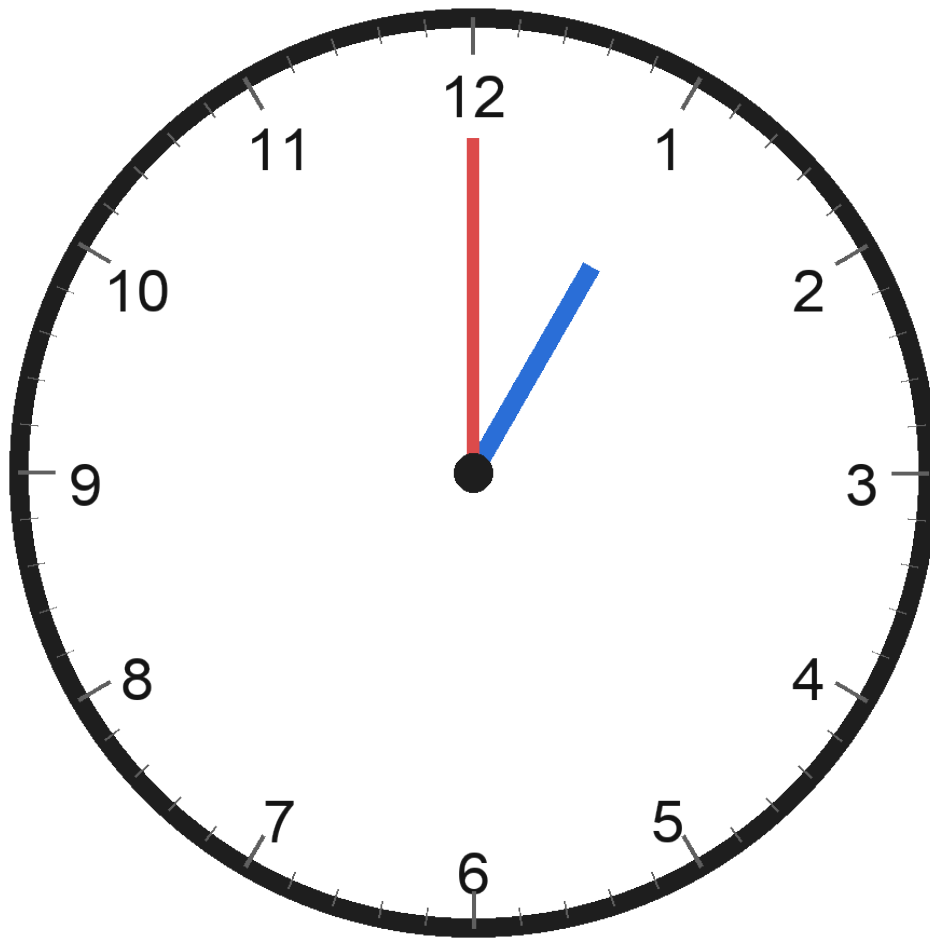
Name the twelve o'clock times; ask and answer a simple question about the time.

Suggested lesson flow

- 1 0-8 min** Present large cards and repeat the times with gestures.
- 2 8-15 min** Order the twelve times with the smaller cards.
- 3 15-27 min** Complete a study worksheet and check together.
- 4 27-37 min** Use the official Classendo Tic-Tac-Toe or Bullseye page for speaking.
- 5 37-45 min** Finish with Clock Line-Up and a spoken exit check.

Movement game - Clock Line-Up

Set-up

Give each learner one small time card. Clear a space so learners can stand in one long line.

How to play

- 1 Learners look at their cards and say: It's ____ o'clock.
- 2 Call: Clock Line-Up! Learners find the correct place from one o'clock to twelve o'clock.
- 3 Check the line together. Each learner says their time in order.
- 4 A learner becomes the caller and asks: Is it ____ o'clock? The class answers: Yes, it is. or No, it isn't.

Teacher language

What time is it? It's three o'clock. Is it six o'clock? No, it isn't.

Teacher notes and answer guide

Worksheet answers

Picture match:

four o'clock, two o'clock, twelve o'clock, ten o'clock, eight o'clock, six o'clock, three o'clock, one o'clock.

Write and respond:

Accept matching time words. Model: What time is it? It's three o'clock. Is it six o'clock? No, it isn't.

Official Classendo play worksheets

Tic-Tac-Toe: learners say the pictured time before writing X or O. Bullseye: learners drop a token, say It's ____ o'clock, then take the printed score.

Teaching tips

- Keep a few large cards visible as language support.
- Accept pointing or one-word answers before asking for a full time sentence.
